

Write in Absentee Ballot Requests for the November 2020 Election can begin immediately. You can write your own application and it need not be in any particular format, but it must contain all of the following information:

1. List your;
 - Full name
 - Date of birth
 - Full registration address including county
 - Mailing address if different from your registration address
 - One of these: Ohio driver's license number, last four digits of your Social Security number or include a copy of an acceptable ID
 - Phone number (optional but suggested)
 - Email Address (optional but suggested)
2. Write: "I am a qualified elector and I'm requesting an absentee ballot for the 11/3/2020 Ohio General election"
3. Sign and Date

Mail in or drop off your application at your county board of elections. If dropping off there is a designated box outside all locations.

Return your voted ballot. You can send it by U.S. Mail or deliver it in person to your county board of elections, but the return envelope containing your marked ballot must either be received by your county board of elections prior to the close of the polls on Election Day, or postmarked no later than the day before the election and received by the board of elections no later than 10 days after the election.
